



BILATERAL MASTECTOMY IN A DACHSHUND – A CASE REPORT

ABSTRACT

A 6 year old female, Dachshund was presented to Veterinary Hospital, APMC yard, Gandhi Gunj, Bidar with a history of small multiple tumor like masses near the left cranial abdominal and around the right caudal mamma. On clinical examination, bitch was apparently healthy, palpable hard mass was noticed around left 3rd cranial and 4th right caudal mamma along with small lumps. The case was diagnosed as mammary tumor. The occurrence of mammary tumor and its surgical management is reported in the present paper.
